



## Memorial Middle School 2023 Read-A-Thon

The Hull PTO's dear friend the Reading Pirate is excited to announce that this year marks the 20<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Hull PTO Read-A-Thon! Here at the Memorial Middle school our goal is for every ELA class to read 20 books. We are joining "Together" with the Jacobs Elementary School to Raise \$20,000.00.

Each student will receive a **Read-A-Thon Pledge Sheet** to bring home and begin collecting pledges. We encourage students to get pledges from relatives and neighbors. 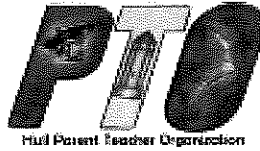
- At the bottom left, click on Add Participant

A daily **Reading Log** will be used to record minutes read and books read. Your classroom teacher will provide you with the reading log in your google classroom. **Final Reading Logs are due on Monday, March 13. The PTO will then award raffle tickets to all students based on these electronic logs.**

Great readers can win great prizes! For the 20th anniversary the Hull PTO will be providing prizes for the Read-A-Thon in several different ways:

1. **Individuals earn Raffle tickets for every \$20 raised or 20 reading minutes logged. Students can then choose which raffles they would like to enter. A full list of prizes will be posted on Monday March 6th.**
2. **Meeting the ELA class goal of 20 books wins a homework pass.**
3. **A pancake, pizza, or ice cream party will be awarded to the grade level that reads the most!**
4. **"Battle of the Books game"- If you guess correctly the final book standing at the end of the battle you will be entered into a special raffle to win a book. There will be daily voting during ELA warm-up.**
